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MEMBERSHIP CONDITIONAL REGISTRATION

All owners and enthusiasts of Italian cars are welcome to become a member of the Scuderia Italian Car Club Inc. Initial Member / Associate Subscription cost is currently \$105.00. This includes the cost of a Club Shirt, Club Key Ring [membership number], and name badge. In subsequent years, membership/associate fee is currently \$60.00. Family Membership is \$25.00. There is no additional joining fee.

Club membership commences 1st July and ends 30th June. **If your car/s are on Conditional Registration and you have not paid your Club Membership fee [due date 30th June each year], you are driving an unregistered and uninsured car.** Please ensure your membership fee is paid up and your log book is current and stamped with the correct year.

Once your car has been granted Conditional Registration, the onus is on the owner of the vehicle to maintain their vehicle in original order and to keep the log book/s up to date.

An annual log book validation (the club organises a day and venue for this) is required. All Members are entitled to register their car/s on Conditional Registration if their pride and joy meets all requirements.

On Sunday the 21st March the Scuderia Italian Car Club BBQ breakfast was held at the Doppietta workshop in Hendon.

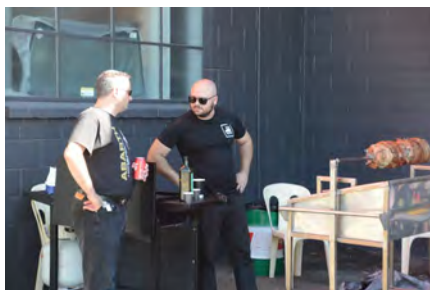

Club Constitution

Updated June 2021

At the June General Meeting a Special General Meeting was called to allow members to vote on a proposed change to the Constitution of the Scuderia Italian Car Club.

The change was proposed to bring the constitution into line with the practice that has been adopted over the last few years in relation to members joining late in the financial year. Paragraph 5.2.c of the constitution stated that *'A new member joining less than six months before the end of the financial year will pay an amount equivalent to half the renewal subscription fee plus the full charge for the Club shirt and key ring, as part of initial membership.'*

The proposed change to Paragraph 5.2.c reads *'At the discretion of the committee, a new member joining less than three months before the end of a financial year will pay the full membership joining fee (which includes full charge for the Club shirt and key ring) to cover the remainder of the current and following financial year.'*

The proposal was carried unanimously by members present at the meeting, and the changes to the Constitution are being ratified in accordance with the Associations Incorporation act 1985. The revised constitution is now available on our website and is now in effect.

I'd like to extend a big thank you to Jamie Tripodi who chaired the General Meeting and facilitated the proceedings to allow me to chair the Special General Meeting. And I'd like to thank all the members who voted in this important meeting either in person or by proxy.

RECIPES

Chicken Marsala

Ingredients

4 thin chicken cutlets (use thigh or breasts—whatever you prefer)

1/2 cup of plain flour

3 tablespoons olive oil

1 cup fresh mushrooms— sliced

1/2 Marsala

1 cup chicken stock

4 cloves garlic—sliced

2 tablespoons butter

Salt and Pepper

1 tablespoons fresh parsley—chopped

Method

1. Season the chicken cutlets with salt and pepper.
2. Dredge the chicken through the flour, shaking off any excess.
3. Heat the olive oil in a large frying pan over a medium—high heat.
4. Add the chicken to the pan and for about 3 minutes on each side or until browned.
5. Remove the chicken when cooked and set aside.
6. Add 2 additional tablespoons of virgin oil to the pan as well as the garlic. Cook the garlic until golden.
7. Add the mushrooms to the pan and saute. Add the chicken stock and the marsala, and turn the heat to low.
8. Simmer until the sauce reduces, then add the butter and let it melt. Add 1 teaspoon of flour to further thicken the sauce.
9. Return the chicken to the pan, turning to coat well. Cover and cook for 2-3 minutes.
10. Sprinkle with parsley and serve.
